






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Special Town Meeting to be held on June 5,2012 motion

To see if the Town will vote to submit to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Legislature a Home Rule Petition to change the use of the landfill from so called "Article 97 Land" as set forth in that certain Order of Taking dated June 10, 1986 and recorded at the Middlesex Registry of Deeds in Book 17090 page 516 which states that the landfill shall be used for providing a park area for public recreation, from park area to use as a ground mounted photovoltaic facility with a leash free dog park and to remove any other encumbrances on the title as may be required, and further that the Board of Selectmen shall be authorized to enter into a lease of said land for a period of twenty years with one extension for no longer than ten years for said purposes and to do or act thereon.
