### MAYNARD CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Minutes, June 9, 2015, 6:40 – 8:13 pm

#### **PRESENT:**

Commission Members: Fred King (chairman), John Dwyer, John Thomas, Jr., Carrie O'Connell, and Jessica Pfeifer.

#### **ADMINISTRATIVE BUSINESS:**

- Review minutes from 05/26/2015. A motion was made, seconded, and approved by all present (5-0) to accept the minutes as amended.

#### **PUBLIC HEARING:**

- None

#### **WETLANDS/STORMWATER ISSUES:**

- Town Hall riverfront violation update. The erosion control was not installed. Mr. King offered to advise the assistant town administrator on where to obtain fiber logs. A snapping turtle laid eggs in the loose dirt and that area is now being protected from trespassers. DPW asked for an extension to file an OOC for the riverfront work.
- Review Stormwater Management Regulations. The agent will email the current version of the draft.
- Review permitting requirements for the 129 Acton sewer project. Rich Harrington provided the Commission an overview of the sewer line project that is proposed for the property at 129 Acton Street and along the abandoned rail corridor to Brown Street. The HydroCAD plans were provided by GPI, so the elevations and wetlands are from the rail trail filing. The plan is to remove and stack the rail ties, stockpile the material from the rail bed, install the sewer line, and use the existing material to bring the rail bed to grade. Three additional manholes will be added to rail bed, and will be installed to just below grade. Siltation controls will need to be added to the plans. The sidewalk along Acton Street will be constructed later and will be included in the filing for 129 Acton Street development.
- Assabet River Wildlife Refuge roadway work and correspondence. The agent will send photos Tom Eagle showing the pile of roadway debris that was piled along the edge of the road adjacent to the wetlands. The Commission is interested to know if more than an acre was altered. The agent will check with Tom Eagle to see if any erosion into the wetland occurred or if erosion control was installed. The Commission suggested taking a walk with Tom Eagle.

#### **LAND MANAGEMENT:**

- Available funding in Conservation land fund. The agent confirmed that the CPC funding was deposited.
