MAYNARD HISTORICAL COMMISSION MEETING  
Tuesday, March 2, 2010 - Maynard Public Library, Cullen Room

This was the rescheduled Feb 16th meeting, which was cancelled due to weather.  
Meeting called to order by Peg Brown at 7:00.

**Members Present:** Peg Brown, Lee Caras, Jack MacKeen, Steven Korbet, and Dave Griffin

**Acceptance of meeting minutes** from the November 17th 2009 and January 21st 2010 Meetings. MOTION to approve the minutes of the 17th by Jack MacKeen, seconded by Steven Korbet, unanimously approved. MOTION to approve the minutes of the 21st by Jack MacKeen, seconded by Dave Griffin, unanimously approved.

**St. Bridget Church Pipe Organ:** Steve visited the church to do some on-the-scene research. The organ dates back to 1895. Apparently the pipes block the rear window and there is a desire to increase the amount of light in the church. Steven and the Commission are supporting parishioners with resources they can use to advocate for the preservation of the organ. The situation is ongoing.

**Town Budget Line Item:** Discussion on the specifics on how the budget request would be made to Town Meeting. MOTION: "To amend the budget submission proposal of the Jan 21st, 2010 meeting to \$1,000, to be funded from the Community Enhancement Stabilization Fund, for the purposes of assisting the Maynard Historical Commission's historic education awareness campaign, including a building marker program, historic preservation awards program, preparation of a map of historically significant properties and landmarks, and other historical education programs." by Jack MacKeen, 2nd Lee Caras, unanimously approved.

**Historic Plaques and Marker Program:** Peg distributed some examples of awards from other towns (Palo Alto / Stanford a specific example). Continuing discussion on ideas surrounding this program will continue on these topics: categories, funding mechanics, standards and formats, awards process, sourcing/vendors

**Upcoming Commission Meeting Dates:** March 16, April 20 (Peg will not be in town). Our May 18th meeting date conflicts with Special Town Meeting. June 15th.

**Clock Tower Place Chimney Antenna Project:** The Commission has responded to the request for comments.
