

CPC Minutes May 9, 2007

Ann has received the last two core documents for proofing and correcting.

Priorities were discussed as part of the housing components. More options are needed for seniors 65 and over. Need to look at Rockport's documents.

Nothing was received from Mike Chambers about recreation or proposal guidelines or checklist.

Because Dave will be out of town for the annual Town Meeting, Lou Ann and Peg will present the warrant article. Remind them to announce about the CPC public meeting on June 13<sup>th</sup> after presenting the article. Dave is putting the notices in The Beacon for May 24<sup>th</sup> and May 31<sup>st</sup> for our June 13<sup>th</sup> meeting. A copy must be presented to the town moderator and clerk before reading.

Peg will have 50 copies of the Community Preservation Plan printed and spiral bound. Email also needs to be up and working by the June 13<sup>th</sup> meeting. Ask Jane if she will help with this.

Sally Bubier brought in financial information for Article 14. Questions will come up whether, for example, CPA funds should be used or Perpetual Care funds for cemetery upkeep. We need to have a rationale for financial positions we propose.

Everyone should continue working on his or her aspect of the CP Plan. Ariel needs to send a copy of the minutes to Carolyn Britt, who will come to our meetings when the selectmen come.

Next meeting will be May 23<sup>rd</sup>, and the summer meetings will be reduced to monthly: June 27, July 25, and August 22.
