3. Chief Stowers and Aaron Miklosko presented on site issues for Crowe Park and Rockland Avenue intersection upgrades. We are hoping for input from VHB (Town engineering firm) by mid-August.
4. Aaron Miklosko suggested we engage with an OPM as soon as possible. Pat Saitta name was mentioned as a potential OPM. – From MHS project.
5. A discussion on reducing the number of sites being considered followed along with whether pre-engineered versus custom design should be evaluated further.
