

Fire Station Building Committee Minutes

August 23, 2016, Maynard Public Library Roosevelt Room

Meeting convened at 6:05 pm

1. Chairman Calabria opened asked for updates on:

- NU-COR – pre-engineered buildings. Chief Stowers is awaiting input from new regional representative.
- Engineering – Building Commissioner provided a written update on existing station and changes from D&W study and FSBC questions.
- Road Trip – Chief Stowers provided information on tour taken by four members of the committee of the newly built Chelmsford Fire Station and the Stow rehab (of a school) that is set to open in October 2016.

Both stations had features and construction challenges we can learn from. Of specific interest to our FD is the use of a bay wide exhaust system that can allow for a safer and less cluttered vehicle floor. Stow is testing and we will consider a similar system if their feedback is positive.

2. Chairman Calabria reviewed a suggestion that we reduce the number of sites being considered from 13 to 5 with the intention of making a narrower recommendation in the fall as we gather more data.

- Tim Lawton asked about Artspace, which is on the list but received a low score.
- A general discussion of eminent domain ensued as several locations would require land taking.
- The pros and cons of town hall, Crowe Park, and the existing station, as a site were reviewed

Motion: To consider Crowe Park and the existing station as finalist locations. Dan Costello, 2nd by Andrew Scribner-MacLean. Voted: Unanimously.

3. Next meeting: September 13, 2016, 6 pm site to be determined.
