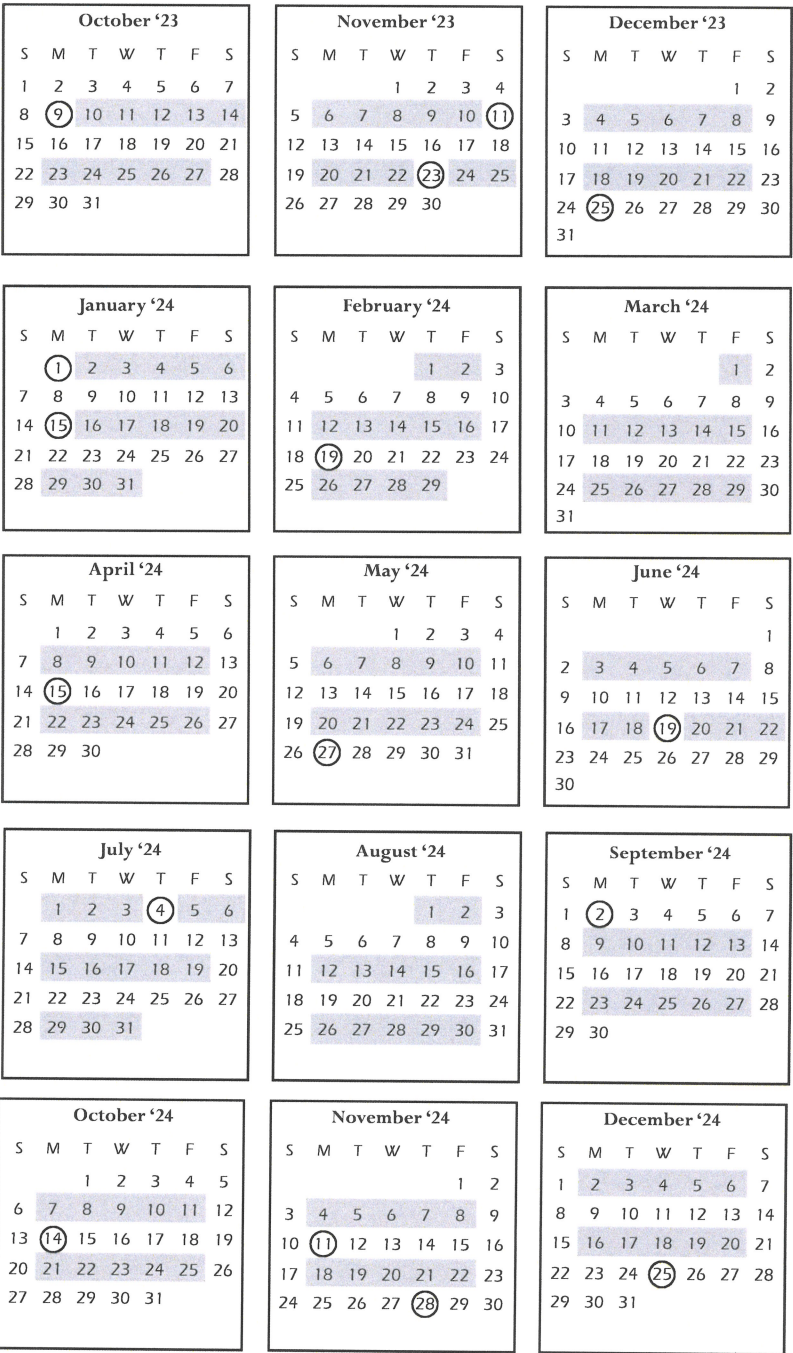
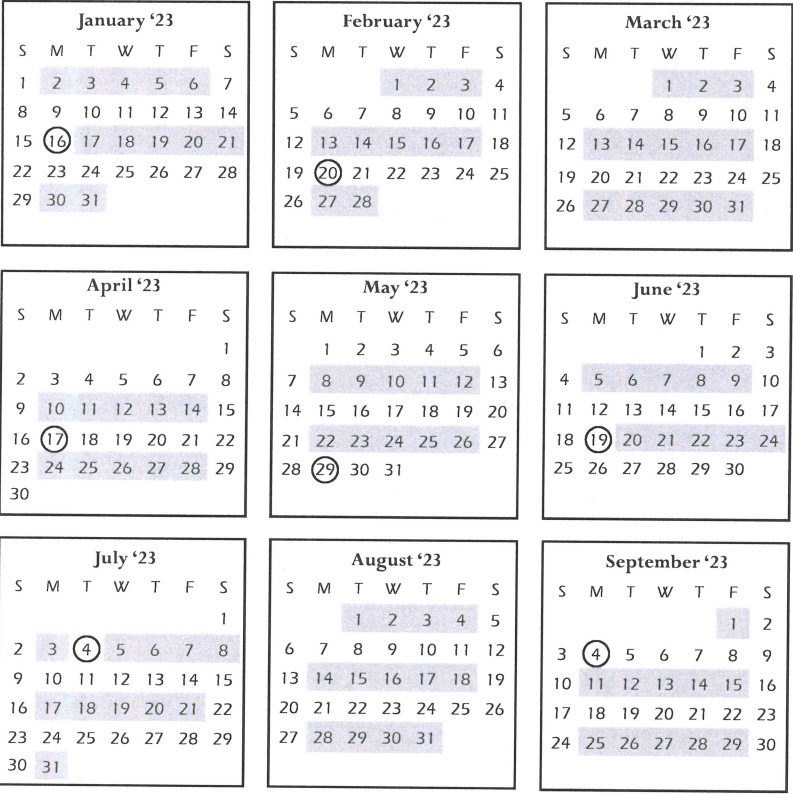
Recyclables are collected every other week on your regular trash collection day, as highlighted in the calendar below.

Friday’s collection will be on Saturday.

PAPER

- Newspapers/inserts
- Magazines
- Paperboard, remove plastic liners (cereal, cracker boxes)
- Corrugated cardboard
- Phone books
- Brown paper bags
- Junk Mail
- Office Paper
- Milk Cartons and juice boxes
- NO** waste paper, plastic coated paper or plastic bags

CONTAINERS

- Glass bottles/jars, all colors & sizes
- Aluminum/tin/steel cans and lids
- Aluminum foil/pie plates
- All plastic containers labeled 1-7
- Aseptic juice boxes
- NO** broken glass or other items (e.g. window glass, dishes, glasses, Pyrex, ceramics, light bulbs)
- NO** cans or bottles containing paint, aerosol or hazardous materials

Single stream recycle

NO PLASTIC BAGS or STYROFOAM in RECYCLING

Return plastic bags to your grocery store.

No TRASH is allowed in Recycling!

WEEKLY TRASH PICK UP

CARTS SHOULD BE PLACED 3 FEET APART AT CURB

CARTS MUST FACE THE STREET

Recycling – Your recyclables are collected every other week

- ♦ All containers should be clean. ♦ Remove and discard caps & rings from all containers.
- ♦ No need to separate paper from other items. ♦ Set bins out by 7am clearly separated from trash.
- ♦ Bins containing improper materials will be left behind.

2023-2024 Maynard Recycling Information

The Town of Maynard has automated curbside collection of single stream recycling. The entire towns recycling will be picked up every other week. Additional carts may be purchased by calling E.L. Harvey. No separation of material is needed, i.e. glass, paper and plastic. All material must be in the cart to be collected and the cart must be curbside away from trash, mailboxes, etc. Must separate by 3 feet between carts for truck access.

Regular Trash – Trash is collected every week

Every bag or barrel(up to 32 gallons or 38 lbs.) of trash set out for trash collection must have a sticker tag(s) on the bag or on the top item in the barrel, in order to be collected.

There are 2 choices in sticker tags depending on the volume/ weight set out:

Bags or barrels up to 15gal./38lbs. require a YELLOW sticker tag- cost of \$2.00

Bags or barrels up to 32 gal./38lbs. require a ORANGE sticker tag- cost of \$4.00

HELPFUL HINTS:

- Use the right sticker tag • buy sticker tags ahead • You'll need them weekly • 2 Yellow = 1 Orange

- The Department of Public Works strictly enforces the 32-gallon barrel rule. Trash left at the curb in barrels larger than 32 gallons will not be picked up.
- No Bulk Items Pickup at Curbside.
- 32 gallon barrels of trash, must be filled only to the level where a cover if applied would fit. Over filled barrels will be left at curbside. Put sticker tag on top item in barrel.
- Do not place sticker tag on barrel.
- In cold weather sticker tags don't stick well to cold bags, so, stick the sticker tag to a warm bag, or to itself wrapped around drawstring or bag neck.
- Mattresses are available at Curbside with direct call to ToughStuff or by dropping them at the Recycle Center on dates opened. Please go to the Towns website for more information.

Seasonal Curbside Yard Waste Collection Weeks

- ♦ Yard Waste is collected during the weeks of:
5/22/2023 – 5/26/2023, 10/30/2023 – 11/3/2023
11/13/2023 – 11/17/2023, 5/20/2024 – 5/24/2024
- ♦ Place leaves, grass, wood chips and all other easily raked material in paper yard waste bags at curbside by 7am on your normal trash collection day during Yard Waste Collection Weeks.
- ♦ All Brush is no longer picked up at curbside. It is now chipped at drop-off Center on predetermined dates.
- ♦ Contact the Department of Public Works at (978) 897-1317.
- ♦ Compost bins are available by contacting Public Works at (978) 897-1317.
