WETLANDS/STORMWATER ISSUES:

- Construction of permanent fence behind HS baseball field. The rear field is within a 100 foot of the buffer zone and borders Natural Heritage priority habitat. The agent will ask the school superintendent regarding the need for the fence and the type of fence proposed.

LAND MANAGEMENT:

- Quote from Assabet Valley Tree for removal of large trees on Summer Street. The original estimate of \$1500 included the large dead elm and the smaller tree over the garage. An updated quote will include both large elm trees. The smaller tree is the responsibility of the property owner.
- Vandalism of Rockland Ave soccer fields. The Maynard Youth Soccer filled in and seeded the tire marks left by vehicles that drove on the soccer fields. MYS requested that the fields are locked during soccer season and during the time when turf improvements are planned.
- The agent will send the property owner at 29 Dix Road a letter concerning encroachment. The Commission provided notice to the home owner a year to move the shed off of Conservation land, but the shed remains.
