### **2014 Historical Marker Program**

### **Coolidge School Statement Feedback**

General support expressed from various town officials. Ellen discussed the Corcoran School in Clinton, which is on the National Register and shares the architect.

### **Glenwood Cemetery Fence**

Discussed expanding the fence rededication to instead include the entire cemetery, seeing as this is also the 10th anniversary of it being listed on the National Register. The Commission will push for a June dedication/celebration date with DPW.
