2014 Historical Marker Program

Glenwood Cemetery Fence

Landscaping is being done in advance of the fence touch up due to Memorial Day. Receiving tomb fence and masonry work starts next Tuesday (27-May), along with the touch up work and repairs to the fence from the winter damage. Expected to take about 1 week.

Cemetery marker sign is also ready and will be installed with the other items.

DPW is proposing repairing the Maynard tomb face (outside of this project).

Currently expecting a \$36K surplus.

Grant Applications

Town Meeting approved the CPA grant for MACRIS Phase 2. Next step is to work with Asst. Town Admin. for the RFP. We are checking into possible vendors.
