2014 Historical Marker Program

Commission has decided to offer the markers to 145 Main and the Brooks House (Summer Street). Jack is in the process of contacting the owners.

Glenwood Cemetery Fence

Status: chain link fence replaced, some finishing work remains; receiving tomb door replaced and fencing removed for manufacturing (eta in the fall). Touch up completed for last year's installation (completing that part of the project).

Glenwood sign: Lee objects to the *fleur-de-lis* on the sign as an inappropriate symbol for the town. The committee concurs that it is not congruent with the architecture of the cemetery. However, we still appreciate the effort of MassCor.

Maynard Family Tomb work by DPW: the Commission endorses a plan for a replica fence (square pickets) and working gate.
