1. Meeting Opening

Mr. DiSilva called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

2. Public Hearing – Lay out for Rockland Avenue

Mr. DiSilva opened the Public Hearing at 7:00 pm for Board of Selectmen to vote on lay out of Rockland Avenue as a public way.

A motion was made by Ms. DiSilva and seconded by Ms. St. John to accept and approve with respect to Rockland Avenue. At this time, the Board of Selectmen will vote to lay out Rockland Avenue as it is shown on a plan entitled “Plan of Land in Maynard, Massachusetts, Prepared for Sweeney & Sons, Inc. 78 Rockland Ave., Maynard, MA. 01754 prepared by Acton Survey and Engineering, and dated August 10, 1999, recorded in the Middlesex South Registry of Deeds as plan 1009 of 2000”. The purpose of the lay out will be to adopt the roadway as a public way.

Board members questioned about the vote for this Layout Hearing. Ms. Bellino, Legal Counsel, advised that this is just about the layout as shown in the plan (Dated August 10, 1999, recorded in the Middlesex South Registry of Deeds as plan of 1009 of 2000).

Mr. Sweeney the petitioner stated that in his lifetime he would like to see this road be accepted by the town. His main concern for this road is the safety of the public as many travel this road. He indicated that last spring the town graded this road and it lasted for about 4 months. If this procedure is repeated to the road again this spring, it should hold up for the next four months. It is understood that this is just one-step in the process for this road to be accepted by town. The next step is proposed acceptance at Town Meeting, May 20, 2019. He added that this road services the town and the community. He reported that the town-owned land abuts 90% of the road. He said it would be a liability to the town in some cases if an accident occurred.
