

**TOWN OF MAYNARD
BOARD OF HEALTH**

Meeting Minutes – May 28, 2019– 6:30 p.m.
OMS Conference Room - Town Hall

The Maynard Board of Health held a scheduled meeting on Tuesday, May 28, 2019 at the Maynard Town Hall beginning at 6:30 p.m., Ronald Cassidy and Lisa Thuot were present. Also present was Kelly Pawluczzonek, Health Agent. Kathy McMillan was not present. Lisa Thuot made a motion to open the meeting at 6:34 pm, Ronald Cassidy, Seconded, all in favor.

New Business:

The Board discussed on whether or not they wanted to have a regulation regarding CBD products specifically for food products. Kelly Pawluczzonek stated that Brookline has a policy, but not a regulation. She also stated that the Massachusetts Department of Agriculture is coming out with Hemp/CBD regulations and that the Board should wait to see what they state. Ronald Cassidy asked of Mass Well Spring would be making CBD products. Kelly that she would confirm with Mass Well Spring, but assumed that the products they made were marijuana derived and not hemp.

The Board discussed banning mint, menthol, and wintergreen flavors to adult only tobacco stores. Kelly Pawluczzonek stated that there is legislation at the state house to ban these items at a state level. The Board stated that they will see where the legislation goes.

Cavan Stone entered the meeting at 6:51 pm for a Green Meadow School update. Kelly Pawluczzonek stated that there really is not much of an update to give as there is no Department of Public Works director to oversee the repairs. The facilities management director stated to the health agent that they were waiting on the school committee to make some decisions with the work that needed to be done. Cavan Stone stated that there was a rodent infestation with feces and urine in the vents. Kelly Pawluczzonek stated that a licensed pest control company had been in and inspected and treated the school for mice. It also showed on the pest control reports that food was being stored in classrooms. Kelly Pawluczzonek will set up a meeting with the Future of the Green Meadow School committee to go over what needs to be done, Ronald Cassidy stated that he will attend the meeting.
