Meeting called to order at 2:01 p.m.

Minutes from February 25, 2021 were approved.

Public Comments: none.

COA Director's Report:

- COA Service Statistics for the month of February were reported.
- Amy gave an update on the current complexities of vaccine distribution for state and local municipalities and the effect on appointments. These issues are impacting Maynard's ability to hold a town clinic. Regionalization of towns and collaboration on vaccine distribution may be available. This would enhance the ability of Maynard residents to receive the vaccine.
- Currently residents of senior and affordable housing are eligible to receive the vaccine as well as homebound individuals. The Town's Health Agent is working with the Maynard Housing Authority to set up clinics. Day/time of clinics will depend on vaccine delivery.

Minuteman Senior Services Report: Mary Beth Coyne was absent due to a conflict in her schedule.

Old Business:

Discussion of the by-laws. Two changes to the appointment terms for members and alternates were approved and voted on. The Board asked that "members" in the by-laws be changed to "members and alternates." Amy will revise and distribute for the next meeting.

New Business:

Paula asked the Board to consider how the Council on Aging could be represented in the Maynard's 150th celebration events. Prior to the pandemic, the COA was preparing to make a memory quilt. The idea of the COA participating in the parade in September was suggested. Anita said she would be able to get a flatbed truck for the COA to do a display.
