**The Maynard BOH hereby orders per MGL Ch 111, S 31:
Face Coverings Required in Maynard as of January 13, 2022**

All members of the public entering any public business premises, including but not limited to grocery stores, pharmacies, home improvement or retail stores and the like must cover their mouth and nose with a mask or cloth face covering, unless exempted by MDPH guidance.

All members of the public entering a restaurant or food establishment premises for purposes dining or picking up food for takeout must cover their mouth and nose with a mask or cloth face covering, unless exempted by MDPH guidance.

All members of the public when entering an indoor municipal property or building, including but not limited to Town Hall, town library, public safety buildings (fire and police) must cover their mouth and nose with a mask or cloth face covering, unless exempted by MDPH guidance.

The following persons are exempt from the face coverings requirement based on MDPH guidance:

- Children under 5 years old.
- Persons for whom a face mask or covering creates a health risk or is not safe because of any of the following conditions or circumstances:
 - the face mask or covering affects the person's ability to breathe safely;
 - the person has a mental health or other medical diagnosis that advises against wearing a face mask or covering;
 - the person has a disability that prevents them from wearing a face mask or covering; or
 - the person depends on supplemental oxygen to breathe.

The Board of Health further advises that individuals are strongly encouraged to utilize masks in line with the latest CDC guidelines and ability to filter for the Omicron variant of COVID-19 when possible.

This shall remain in effect until further notice, and will be reviewed at each subsequent BOH meeting, pursuant to our judgement that the conditions leading to this order no longer exist.
